Main Street Murals (MSM)/Friends of Desert Discovery Center will be hosting a virtual public and stakeholder ZOOM meeting on Thursday, February 17 from 4.30pm - 5.30pm to gather input on the development of an off-highway vehicle (OHV) Safety/Education grant proposal for submission to the California State Parks, Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division. The grant application is currently being prepared by MSM staff for the 2023 grant cycle and we seek the valuable input from our stakeholders and the general public.

This is the third year that MSM has applied for a Safety/Education grant from the California Department of Parks and Recreation OHMVR Division to help fund and coordinate the BLM Barstow Field Office Safety/Education OHV program. The grant supports OHV Safety/Education activities such as visitor services, outreach, and education at OHV events, schools, and on BLM-managed public lands throughout the Barstow Field Office.

A scoping meeting is scheduled for the first 30 minutes of the session; the stakeholder meeting will immediately follow. Stakeholders and members of the public are invited to attend either session, or both. The website will provide detailed instructions for accessing the preliminary applications and submitting comments. Public comments should be submitted to both the OHMVR Division and to the appropriate BLM field office by May 3, 2022.
